The housing numbers have risen from 22,563 in the previous Local Plan with no consultation. The number of strategic development sites has risen from 3 to 7. The new Strategic Sites have not received comprehensive appraisals in the way that the first 3 have.

This Local Plan is seeking to destroy the Oxford Green Belt and will

- a) encourage the expansion of Oxford city into the countryside
- c) will destroy valuable countryside including SSSI's
