Obj 1.4 developing Chalgrove does not "focus growth in the Science Vale", it disperses it

Obj 4.2 development at Chalgrove has little or no chance of being part of any integrated or sustainable transport scheme to any other area

Obj 6.1 development at Chalgrove airfield directly contradicts the Chalgrove Neighbourhood Plan

Obj 8.2 SODC's objective of minimising carbon emissions and other pollutants will not be helped by developing Chalgrove, increased numbers of cars will obviously increase pollution
