I have serious concerns about the soundness of STRAT 13. There are no robust plans for supporting infrastructure in terms of roads. The Marsh Lane flyover has an accident record, is unlit at night and heavily congested at peak hours. Adding an additional junction here would be very dangerous and would increase congestion. More thought also needs to be given to the way the developer connects with Barton Park. Without connection, this new development will be isolated on the edge of the city.

A new primary school has been proposed but an assumption has been made that secondary school pupils will be absorbed into existing schools. The only school which might be have space would be the planned Swan School. However, even this school may be at capacity by the time any development occurs on this site.
