It does not appear that the proper consultation has taken place on this version of the Plan as it is very different to the previous plan in 2017. There have been changes to the proposed housing sites that were not even mentioned in the previous version ie Grenoble Road for one. The plan does not factor in either the proposed Oxford to Cambridge Expressway. Therefore the proposed plan to develop the land at Grenoble Road which is in Green belt should be removed altogether from the plan.

Therefore the proposed plan to develop the land at Grenoble Road for housing which is in Green belt should be removed altogether from the plan. If it were to go ahead it would result in loss of precious greenbelt land forever, which is currently enjoyed by local people for leisure activities. If the plan were to go ahead, including the proposed park and ride, there would be major impact on traffic on the already busy A4074, especially through the historic village of Nuneham Courtenay where properties are already shaken by the speed and size of some vehicles and where it is even now extremely difficult to pass from one side of the village to the other. In my view the village would become even more of a bottleneck, and villagers would be unable to exit and access their own homes, in safety, or even to cross the roads. There would be an increase too in noise and air pollution which already makes villagers's lives difficult.
