The plan shows little recognition of the existing problems of commuting down the Abingdon, Iffley and Cowley Roads which bottle neck over two bridges to enter the city. The A34 Southern Ring Road is increasingly blocked with traffic. It is unlikely that improved public transport and a new Park and Ride will mitigate the traffic implications an additional 3000 households with 1 to 2 cars each.

The A4074 will also have predictably more traffic flow from these and other developments to the south.

It appears to be assumed that assessments of traffic flow and mitigation measures will happen associated with the plans for developments. This will be too late.
