**With reference to STRAT 12 Northfield**

I am writing to object to the inclusion of the Northfield housing site in the Local Plan 2034 because I have never been consulted about this at any point in the development of the Local Plan and therefore it is not "legally compliant or sound".

I object to the use of this site in the Green Belt near Horspath because it is important to keep this land open so that it separates the village of Horspath from the industrial zone of Cowley and thus maintains its status as a village. I moved to Horspath 39 years ago because I wanted to live in a village and I do not want it to become a suburb of Cowley.

I object to the building of the Northfield housing estate on this part of the Green Belt near Horspath because it would ruin the beautiful views of the rural landscape and the access to it on foot from the village, and no "exceptional circumstances" exist for removing the Northfield Site from the Green Belt.

The building of Northfield on Green Belt is in conflict with SODC's Policy 'STRAT 6: Green Belt' in the Plan and the harm caused by removing the Northfield site from the Green Belt is greater than any benefits obtained.

I would like to participate in the oral hearings part of the legal Examination in Public in the summer and would like to be added to the database for receiving further information about the Local Plan 2034.

**I request that Northfield is completely taken out of the Local Plan 2034.**
