This plan has only been recently submitted unbeknown to all residents who live on Sandhills. As far as I can see no environmental or risk assessments have been done to check a suitable location for housing. Our local parish council new nothing about it. This area is recognised as an area of outstanding natural beauty which has the highest status of protection. We have wildlife in abundance which my children and the local school children have loved to watch. The bridle path is well used by people walking dogs and also used by horse . The local school take the children to the area as many fossils are located there. The local school uses Delbush as part of school cycling proficiency test as the roads are safe and quiet to use. We have many children who play in the streets and the roads and bridle path are used by children walking to school and using facilities in Barton. Air pollution would increase tremendously with more cars in such a small area. The roads are far too narrow for emergency services to get down and it would be dangerous to allow more congestion on our roads, I have seen this for myself when an Ambulance got stuck in Delbush Avenue because of parking. We are an avenue with many wonderful trees which would be destroyed. National planning policy requires Councils to release Green Belt only after all other options have been explored. As far as I can see this is not the case. The traffic lights are very busy during school pick up/drop of and this would be extremely exacerbated by lots more traffic and extremely dangerous to children using the roads during these times. We also have vulnerable people living in the area and a Charity who look after bereaved children, this would impact on them terribly. I see no compliance at any stage when considering this space for housing and at no time has there ever been evidence to suggest that the Local Development Scheme for Local Plan 2034 is publicly available to see. We would become a rat run for people trying to avoid the Green rd roundabout and we do not have the infrastructure for this.
