I object to the imposition of 233 houses in Goring. Goring is unique in the District: it is wholly in one AONB; in the setting of another; and partly in the River Thames floodplain.

These constraints are well set out in the Current Goring Neighbourhood Plan (presently going through Examination) and there is plenty of evidence in that document as to why Goring can take no more than 94 houses.

You acknowledge in the Plan that you have a duty to protect and enhance AONBs and to reduce flood risk, but you seem to take no account whatsoever of these duties when imposing extra houses in Goring.
